Tsiyon Answer - ..Statement of Faith

Thank you for your kind thoughts towards Tsiyon Ministry. Thanks also for your request for information. On your first point, while we know it is quite normal these days for ministries to post a Mission Statement and Statement of Faith in the form of a brief list of points, and is therefore normal to ask for those, we find ourselves unable to participate in that practice because of Scriptural considerations. Of course, we could simply say that we are bondslaves of Y'shua Messiah and as such are totally devoted to following Him in doing the Father's will, and that we believe without reservation in the Spirit-Inspired Scriptures as the standard of all Truth. This is precisely our position. Beyond that it becomes impossible to select some points of truth out of all Scripture to pull into an appropriate list of beliefs, while leaving many other important truths out of the list (how is that possible since its ALL important? see 2 Tim 3:16+17). The truth is, the entire Scriptures provide both our Mission and our Statement of Faith, and we dare not reduce those to something less. Since that is our conviction we must let our many recorded hours of teachings and hundreds of pages of books and articles speak for us regarding both our work and our message.

Thoughts from Eliyahu ben David:

If you just finished reading the joke immediately above you are probably laughing right now. I know I was after I read it. I also realized there is a real point to the joke. That is - there is a huge gap between Hebraic thinking and our Greco-Roman common culture. That gap often leads to huge misunderstanding. I know that here at Tsiyon we are constantly trying to bridge that gap - to communicate Hebraic-based truth that doesn't easily fit into the Greco-Roman mind. That is our biggest challenge. Passover is such a good example of that gap. So many around us do not see the Pass It On relevance of keeping Passover, while it is vital to us. In one sacred meal we celebrate our nationa deliverance from Egypt, our personal deliverance from sin, death and the world by our Passover Lamb - and even our future deliverance just ahead in the Second Exodus. Bunnies and painted eggs are both inappropriate and trivial compared to this! And yet, many sincere believers still just don't know the difference. I pray that we, who do know the difference, can find the love, grace and concern for those around us to do what we can to communicate the profound meaning of this Passover to others, as we are moved, strengthened and encouraged by it ourselves.

Dawn and I want to take this opportunity to wish you and yours all of the profound and abundant blessings of this Passover season.


