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Praiseworthy Women Discussion

From Eliyahu

Life in the 21st Century is complex, and can be difficult for anyone. In this message I am specifically talking about balancing the roles of wife and mother with other life demands, starting with your personal faith, your spiritual community, secular work, and any of 101 other things that may be part of a believing women's life. Being a disciple of Yeshua gives you resources others don't have, such as the empowerment of the Holy Spirit, and the experience of His love and care for you. Even if you don't get it all perfect sometimes, He is always there to make the

difference. Just knowing that builds courage to face the day and His peace in your heart.

Then there is His Word, filled with such amazing wisdom and food for the soul! To balance out the demands of life more easily remember these few Biblical principles that help to make for a happy and productive life. How these will apply in your life is something you will need to discern as you go, because of individual circumstances, but here are a few general principles that have been especially useful to praiseworthy women.

1. Prioritizing Your Relationship with your Father in Heaven

Your relationship with your Heavenly Father must be the foundation of your life. Spending time in prayer, reading the Bible, and seeking His guidance will help you navigate your responsibilities. The amazing thing here is, He wants to be a part of every little thing going on in your life - and the big things too! Don't hold back from telling Him everything. Of course, He already knows, but when you are in constant communication with Him you are creating the opening for Him to speak to you. Now, that's a real relationship!

"In nothing be anxious, but in everything, by prayer and petition with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your thoughts in Messiah Yeshua." (Philippians 4:6-7)

2. Nurturing Your Marriage

A strong marriage is crucial for a stable family life. It takes two for this to happen. Strive to make your husband's interests your own. Build trust by communicating openly and honestly. Remember that nobody is perfect, so instead of being a critic, be a prayer partner. You can't beat this simple advice:

"However, each one of you also must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband." (Ephesians 5:33)

3. Raising Your Children with Love, Guidance and Discipline

We all know our children need love and guidance. Strive to be a positive role model and teach them according to biblical principles. They need discipline too, but this is harder. Society today frowns on discipline, and I grant you, it can be uncomfortable and unpleasant to be the "bad guy." Why should you do that? Here's why:

"The rod of correction gives wisdom, but a child left to himself causes shame to his mother. (Proverbs 29:15)

"Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it." (Proverbs 22:6-7)

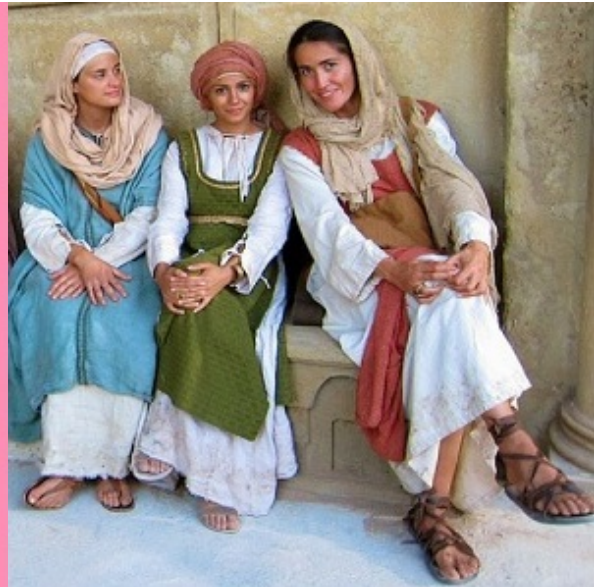
4. Balancing Secular Work and Family

Its best for a mom with young children to be in the home with her kids. However, in today's world that is not always possible. Balancing work with family responsibilities requires careful planning and flexibility. Set realistic goals and boundaries to meet the needs of your family while also meeting your work obligations. Granted, that's not easy, but who said life was going to be easy? This is true: your family will see how hard you try, and love will make the difference. Shalom.

(Mark 2:27-28)

Life can be unpredictable, and it's important to trust that God has a plan for you and your family. Trust Him and don't be afraid to move with the Spirit into all of God's Will for your life. Lean on your faith during challenging times and seek His wisdom.

*"YHWH is my shepherd:

He restores my soul.
He guides me in the paths of righteousness for his names sake."*
(Psalms 23:1-4)
